1. Technical Adviser for NITDB (NIRTTP/PCO/S/IND-28) – National/Full time/ Service location at Sub-PCO/NITDB

Key Qualification: Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering with at least 10 years of experience in the planning, design, and implementation of infrastructure (roads, buildings, bridges, dry ports etc) Projects; or Master's Degree in Civil/Structural Engineering/Construction Management or relevant subject with at least Five years of experience in the planning, design, and implementation of infrastructure (roads, buildings, bridges, dry ports etc) Projects

2. Technical Adviser for DoTM (NIRTTP/PCO/DOTM/S/IND-29) – National/Full Time/Service location at Sub-PCO/DoTM

Key Qualification: Minimum Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering or Automobile/Mechanical Engineering with at least 10 years of experience in the related field or Master's Degree in Civil/Highway/Transportation or Automobile/Mechanical Engineering or relevant subject with at least Five years of experience in the related field.
