**Feasibility Study & Topographic Survey of ICD at Dodhara-Chadani Area and  
Development of a Conceptual Plan**

In order to facilitate development of a dry-port in Dodhara-Chadani Area (Kanchanour), Nepal Intermodal Transport Development Board (NITDB) under the Ministry of Commerce(MOC) invites eligible consulting firms with basic expertise in CD planning and trade & transport infrastructure design, which do not have conflict of interest with NITDB, to indicate their interest in providing consulting services. The services include study of existing trace volume, identification of appropriate site for ICD construction, conducting topographic survey of the land required, cadastral mapping and development of a conceptual plan for the ICD and ancillary structures.

Interested consulting firms should provide information demonstrating that they have the capacity and motivation to perform the services. The short listing criteria include but will not be limited to:

- Business objective, corporate capacity (annual turnover, financial information for the last 5 years) and expertise of the firm
- Organization structure
- Details on the JV partners and the leading firm
- General work experience and similar work completed in the last 10 years and their complexity
- A list of proposed personnel with qualification, experience, and association with the firm.
- Commitment for adherence to the code of ethics and anticorruption policy of the government.

Consulting firms may associate to enhance their qualifications. The selection will be based on QCBS methodology. The work has to be completed within 4 months. Further information could be obtained from NITDB office or its website.
